


### **Caring for our Common Home**

# **Updated Relationships, Sex and Health Education (RSHE) Policy**

All primary schools must teach RSHE as part of the curriculum. At STM, we follow an RSHE curriculum produced by Ten: Ten which is approved by the Birmingham Diocese and has been written to be age-appropriate for children across the primary age range. The curriculum covers aspects such as what a healthy friendship looks and feels like; responding positively to peer pressure and having an understanding of key life events, such as new life and death.

We have recently renewed our <u>RSHE Policy</u> which you can view at the end of the newsletter. If you have any questions about how the curriculum is delivered in your child's class, please speak to your child's class teacher.

Early Help services can help families, children and young people - pre-birth to 19 years old and 25 years old where there are special educational needs or disabilities

We monitor all pupils' attendance and will contact you (often by letter and text message) if their attendance is getting lower than we'd expect. Please don't be offended - we have a duty to keep you informed of things that can affect your child's progress and/or wellbeing.
